Mira Costa High School football games represent a long tradition of being an event where our community comes together on Friday night to cheer on our Mustangs. After opening the season with two straight away games, MCHS is excited to host its first home game of the 2023 season. The primary focus and goal of MCHS administration is the safety and comfort of all attendees at our games. Please review the following rules before attending any Mira Costa football games.

Student Entry

- ASB Markers will allow you free admission to the game; however, you MUST present your school ID at the gate for entry. Please note that screenshots of a school ID will not be accepted.
- There are no IN/OUT privileges at Varsity Football Games. Once you leave, there is no re-entry.
- All non-high school-age students must be accompanied by their own parent/adult.
- Please be aware that no backpacks, bags or drink containers will be allowed in the game.

Parent/Adult Entry

- Tickets are available online via GoFan or by clicking [HERE](#).
- Cash ticket purchases are available on game day starting at 6:15pm at the Peck ticketing entrance or the Meadows ticketing entrance to Waller Stadium.
- Parents can enter with their own children only to the game. If a friend of their child would like to attend, they must be with their own parent(s).
- Parents/Adults are responsible for monitoring all students they bring to the game.

Non-approved Areas: The following areas are off limits to spectators:

- Track area around the stadium
- Athletic Complex and Gym
- MCHS hallways or quad

Spectator Expectations

- Respectful behavior towards all in attendance with the goal that everyone, especially visiting teams and their families, feel safe and welcome.
- All spectators must remain out of the non-approved areas at all times.
- All spectators must abide by the directions of supervision personnel at all times.
- Avoid congregating on Stadium Way.
- Any students creating a disturbance and/or caught in non-approved areas will be directed to leave.
 - Consequences per the behavior/discipline matrix will be administered for any MCHS, MBMS or Hermosa USD student who does not abide by the rules. This may include being banned from future games.
 - Students from other schools will be referred to their admin for discipline.
 - Resident and non-resident students who do not attend MCHS schools may be banned from future games as well.

Our overall goal and focus is to create a community experience where all attendees can enjoy the game. We look forward to upholding the MCHS tradition in a manner that is both positive and safe, reflecting the excellence of the Manhattan Unified School District.
