Statement of Regulations

Dear Student/Parent/Guardian/Administrator:

1. Please read all parts of this document and sign where indicated.
2. Return form to MCHS Student Store with check/cash to purchase tickets.
3. Ticket Prices include admission to the dance, refreshments, and activities
4. **Homecoming 2024** is at The **Mira Costa Athletic Complex** on **Saturday, October 19, 2024 7:00 PM-11:00 PM**
5. **Dress Attire:** This event is semi-formal. Wear "dressy" clothes. ☺
Reminder: Footwear should be soft soled shoes.
6. All students & guests **MUST ARRIVE BY 8:30 P.M.**
NO STUDENTS WILL BE ADMITTED LATE
NOR WILL TICKETS BE REFUNDED!
7. Mira Costa Administrators and Staff reserve the right to end the event early if liquor is present at the event. (It is unlawful for minors to consume or possess alcohol.)
8. California Education Code 48900(q) specifies that a pupil may be suspended or expelled for acts related to substance abuse that occur while on school grounds, and traveling to or from a school-sponsored activity. When one is engaged in a school-sponsored activity, the following consequences will apply to any students found in possession and/or under the influence of alcohol, controlled substances, or look-alike substances, or involved in any type of fighting, theft, vandalism, or defiance of authority. By signing this form, all dance attendees and parents agree to submit to a breathalyzer test if requested by the administration (either randomly or specifically).

Consequences for negative behaviors at the event include but are not limited to:

- Exclusion from the activity and referral to the appropriate authority.
- Suspension or expulsion from school.
- Exclusion from the following:
 1. Senior Recognition
 2. Commencement
 3. Senior Breakfast
 4. Grad Nite Activities sponsored by PTSA
- Restitution for damages, if applicable.
- 10. The Mira Costa High School SRO (School Resource Officer), Security, Administration, Guidance Counselors and/or Teachers will randomly use an intoximeter (breathalyzer) as the students arrive at the event.
In the event of student/guest misconduct, the Principal/Principal's designee (any members of the Chaperone group) will immediately attempt to notify parent(s)/ guardian(s) about the nature of the infraction and the consequences.

Any student in possession of illegal substances is subject to arrest.
Appropriate disciplinary action will occur at school the week after Prom.

** MCHS Administration encourages parents to prohibit pre-dance parties that permit the consumption of alcohol or other illegal substances as this type of party increases the student's chance of having problems during the event and may put the party host in a vulnerable legal position.

* It is against the law to furnish any alcoholic beverage to any person under the age of 21 years per the Business and Professions Code, Section 25658. Liability for injury or death of a person who was furnished alcohol is contained in the Business and Professions Code, Section 25602.

** If limousines/busses are used, the school recommends that parents make the arrangements & require drivers to abide by both school policies and California State Law.
